| 1. Are you connected to a<br>Prescription Exchange Service<br>(PES)? | <ul> <li>eRX &amp; Medisecure are the two Prescription Exchange Services (PES) available in Australia.</li> <li>In order to retrieve electronic prescriptions, you will need to be connected to a PES.</li> <li>Note: You do not need to be registered with both services. eRX and Medisecure are interoperable and therefore you can scan any barcode from either PES and download the prescription.</li> </ul> | If you aren't connected to a<br>PES, please contact <u>eRX</u> or<br><u>Medisecure</u> to register. |

| 2. Are you connected to<br>MyHealthRecord (MyHR)?                         | Electronic prescriptions require information like HPI-O, HPII and<br>IHIs that are normally accessible if you are connected to MyHR.   | To <b>register</b> your pharmacy for<br>MyHR please follow this <u>guide</u> .   |

|   | <ul> <li>You will need a NASH PKI certificate to connect to MyHR with Z Dispense.</li> <li>To confirm if you are connected to MyHR in Z Dispense: <ul> <li>Check if you have the MyHR icon next to a patient's name.</li> <li>It will look something like S OR S. If you have this icon, you are connected to MyHR</li> <li>Ensure your certificates are not expired. Z Dispense will prompt upon startup if your MyHR Certificates (NASH PKI) are expired.</li> </ul> </li> </ul> | To <b>renew expired NASH PKI</b><br>certificates, please login into<br>your <u>PRODA account</u> to request<br>for updated certificates. Once<br>you have the certificate and the<br>PIC, please contact Z Software<br>and we will help you update<br>the certificates.<br>To learn more how to use<br><b>MyHR in Z Dispense</b> , please<br>refer to our <u>knowledgebase</u><br><u>article</u> . |
| 3. Do your barcode<br>scanners meet the minimum<br>hardware requirements? | It is recommended to use a <b>2D barcode scanner</b> to scan<br>electronic prescriptions as they support scanning QR codes that<br>are commonly used for electronic prescriptions.   | <ul> <li>Please check if your existing barcode scanners are 1D or 2D.</li> <li>If you require a 2D scanner, these are the 2 models that we recommend: <ul> <li>Motorola DS9208</li> <li>NewLand FR4080</li> </ul> </li> </ul>  |
