<input type="checkbox"/> 1. Are you connected to a Prescription Exchange Service (PES)?	<p>eRX & Medisecure are the two Prescription Exchange Services (PES) available in Australia.</p> <p>In order to retrieve electronic prescriptions, you will need to be connected to a PES.</p> <p>Note: You do not need to be registered with both services. eRX and Medisecure are interoperable and therefore you can scan any barcode from either PES and download the prescription.</p>	<p>If you aren't connected to a PES, please contact eRX or Medisecure to register.</p>

<p><input type="checkbox"/> 2. Are you connected to MyHealthRecord (MyHR)?</p>	<p>Electronic prescriptions require information like HPI-O, HPII and IHIs that are normally accessible if you are connected to MyHR.</p> <p>You will need a NASH PKI certificate to connect to MyHR with Z Dispense.</p> <p>To confirm if you are connected to MyHR in Z Dispense:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Check if you have the MyHR icon next to a patient’s name. It will look something like  OR . If you have this icon, you are connected to MyHR <input type="checkbox"/> Ensure your certificates are not expired. Z Dispense will prompt upon startup if your MyHR Certificates (NASH PKI) are expired. 	<p>To register your pharmacy for MyHR please follow this guide.</p> <p>To renew expired NASH PKI certificates, please login into your PRODA account to request for updated certificates. Once you have the certificate and the PIC, please contact Z Software and we will help you update the certificates.</p> <p>To learn more how to use MyHR in Z Dispense, please refer to our knowledgebase article.</p>

Do your barcode scanners meet the minimum hardware requirements?</p>	<p>It is recommended to use a 2D barcode scanner to scan electronic prescriptions as they support scanning QR codes that are commonly used for electronic prescriptions.</p>	<p>Please check if your existing barcode scanners are 1D or 2D.</p> <p>If you require a 2D scanner, these are the 2 models that we recommend:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Motorola DS9208 • NewLand FR4080
